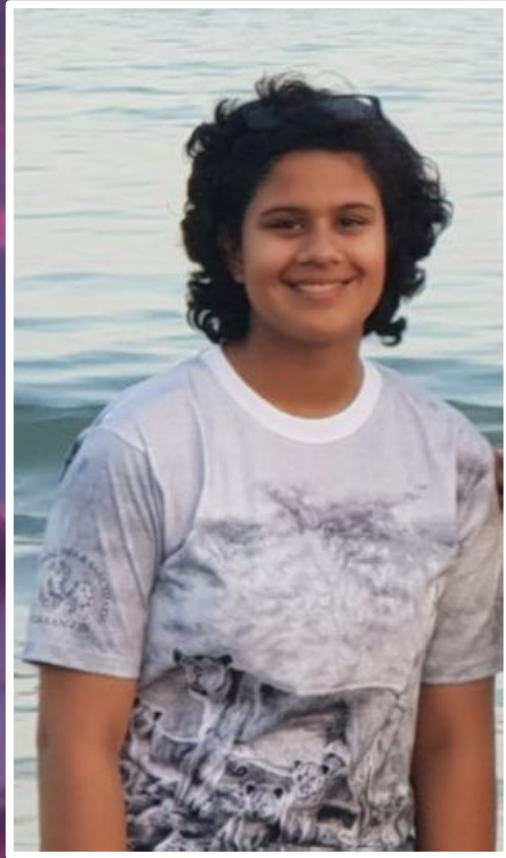


UNSC: VICE CHAIRPERSON:
